Supplies needed From Home: -Blank Paper -Washable Markers -Paper Towels -Bible marked at Romans 1:20

In vour Kit: -FOCUS Notebook -Thumb "Pictionary" cards -Magnifying glass -"What do you see"

•Opener – Thumb-Pictionary – Place the stack of "Pictionary" cards face down. Kids and parents take turns drawing a card from the pile and then draw the picture for the others to guess. First, make their thumb prints by coloring one thumb with a washable marker, then draw designs around them like the cards (cloud, sunshine, etc.).

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•Bible point – After playing the game, use the magnifying glass, or the magnifier on your phone, to have kids look closely at their fingerprints. Have them describe something unique they see about their prints. Explain that we have all been made in God's image, and God made everything we enjoy in creation. Romans 1:20 tells us that we can understand more about God by looking at what he created.

•Today's bottom line is FOCUS on what you can SEE. When we look at everything that God made it points us to him!

•Activity - As a family fill out the "What do

you see" activity sheet as a scavenger hunt!

•FOCUS notebook (this can be saved for bedtime)- draw something God made OR finish the sentence, "I see you God when I focus on..."

•Close in prayer – "God, you are amazing! You are so creative! We just have to look at the numbers of the colors in the world to see your creativity. You love us so much. Thank you for showing us who you are in vour creation! In Jesus' name. Amen."
