**BASIC TRUTH**

**I can trust God no matter what.**

**WHAT YOU DO:**

- Have someone read you the following questions:
  - Would you rather fly like a bird or swim like a dolphin? If your answer is fly like a bird, color the face orange; if your answer is swim like a dolphin, color the face yellow.
  - Would you rather eat pizza or ice cream? If your answer is pizza, color the right arm red; if your answer is ice cream, color the right arm green.
  - Would you rather sing or dance on stage in front of a group of people? If your answer is sing, color the left arm blue; if your answer is dance, color the left arm brown.
  - Would you rather be able to run as fast as a cheetah or be as strong as an elephant? If your answer is cheetah, color the left leg orange. If your answer is elephant, color the left leg blue.
  - Would you rather have the chance to direct a movie or invent a new toy? If your answer is directing a movie, color the right leg purple. If your answer is inventing a new toy, color the right leg green.
  - Would you rather have a pet dragon or a pet unicorn? If your answer is a dragon, draw and color scales on the body. If your answer is a unicorn, color the body with a rainbow of colors.
- Do you think anyone would have an identical gingerbread man?
- What does unique mean? God created each of us different from each other.
- Look up and read Genesis 1:26-27.
  - How are humans different from any other of God's creations?
  - Despite our differences as people, what do all of us have in common?
  - What does it mean to be made in the image of God?
- Even though it may be hard to define what it means to be made in God's image, we can say we reflect God in a way no other part of His creation does!
