MONTHLY LIFE APP

Individuality—Discovering who you're meant to be so you can make a difference

BASIC TRUTH

I should treat others the way

WHAT YOU DO:

Look up at read 1 Corinthians 12:27

What does it mean that each one of us is part of the body of Christ?

- We are all made in God's image
- Jesus sees us as valuable
- We all have gifts and we should use our gifts to help others.
- We can make a difference right now—we don't have to wait until we are older to make a difference.

Now:

- Fill a clear glass with water.
- Fold a piece of paper in half and write "Jesus" on it.
- Fold another piece of paper in half and write "We can make a difference."
- Draw an arrow on another piece of paper.
- Stand the papers on a table.
- Place the glass of water between the two folded pieces of paper.

When we use our gifts, we make a difference.

• Hold the arrow in front of the glass of water pointing towards the paper labeled, "We can make a difference."

However, when we believe Jesus is who He says He is, AND we use our gifts TOGETHER, our gifts get supercharged and together we can make a GREATER difference.

 Move the arrow behind the glass so you are looking through the glass of water at the arrow.

We make a GREATER difference because we point others to Jesus. (Note: As you look through the water at the arrow, the direction the arrow points should change; the arrow should now be pointing to Jesus. If necessary, increase the distance between the glass and the paper until the arrow points to Jesus.)
