# I CAN!

WHAT YOU NEED: "I Can Activity Book" Activity Page and crayons

#### WHAT YOU DO:

Parents, help your child get started by folding the activity page in half lengthwise, and then in half again widthwise to make a book.

First, write your name in the space on the front of your book. Ask for help if you need it! It says, '[Your name] is wonderfully made in God's image.' You can decorate the cover after you write your name.

Now open your book. This page says, 'God made me to think.' Look at the pictures and think about which pictures match. When you find a match, draw a line from one to the other. When you're done, you can color the pictures.

The next page says, 'God made me to create.' It has flower stems on it but no flowers. Take a few minutes to draw colorful flowers on each stem.

Now turn to the last page. It says, 'God made me to help.' Look at the picture. What are some ways you can help? Now you can color the picture."

God made you to be like Him. That means God made you to think, create, and help! Those are all wonderful things! Who made you wonderful? God made you wonderful!
