WHAT YOU DO:

- Cut out the cards on each page, but be sure to keep the pages of cards together and separate from the other pages.
- Place all the "Intro" cards together, doing the same thing for the "Conflict" cards, "Resolution" cards, and "Ending" cards.
- Create your own story by selecting one card from each of the four categories.
- Read your story in order (1. Intro, 2. Conflict, 3. Resolution, and 4. Ending)
- Take some time to create more stories. Read them aloud to someone if you want!
- Just like you made choices to create your own story, you have choices to make every single day. Sometimes those choices are small, such as choosing whether or not to pick up your Lego® bricks. But sometimes they are big decisions that could influence a friendship or even have a long-lasting impact on your life!
- Think about:
 - When you know what the right thing to do is, why do you sometimes choose the wrong thing?
 - What kinds of situations are more difficult for you to choose the right thing?
